Proposed study to review Growth Management Tools for Bowen Island

The Chair presented a draft proposal prepared by the Chair and Ted Bentley regarding a study to review growth management tools for Bowen Island.

The Commission discussed the following issues related to the draft proposal to review growth management tools:

- Meaning of the term “growth management” - public education could be enhanced through articles in the Undercurrent;
- Whether the list of study items should be reduced or sent forward as an open-ended list;
- The need to define tools related to growth management;
- The study represents an opportunity to involve the community and improve public understanding of the Municipal process;
- Product of the study would be a report addressing each of the elements listed in the study regarding present status and recommended actions;
- Steps involved in the Study –
 1. Inventory of existing tools
 2. Gap analysis
 3. Recommendations to fill the gaps
 4. Report to Council
