

BOWEN ISLAND MUNICIPALITY
BYLAW No. 173, 2006

A Bylaw to amend
“Bowen Island Municipality Building Numbering Regulatory Bylaw No.25, 2000”

WHEREAS, Council has established a bylaw to regulate building numbering within Bowen Island Municipality through “Bowen Island Municipality Building Numbering Regulatory Bylaw No. 25, 2000”;

AND WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary to amend “Bowen Island Municipality Building Numbering Regulatory Bylaw No. 25, 2000”;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Bowen Island Municipality in open meeting assembled enacts the following:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the “*Bowen Island Municipality Building Numbering Regulatory Bylaw No. 25, 2000, Amendment Bylaw No. 173, 2006*”.
2. Section 10, of Bylaw 25, 2000 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

“10. Every person who offends against any of the provisions of this Bylaw or who suffers or permits any act or thing to be done in contravention or in violation of any of the provisions of this Bylaw, or who neglects to do or refrains from doing anything required to be done by any of the provisions of this Bylaw, or who does any act or thing which violates any of the provisions of this Bylaw, shall be deemed to be guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw, and shall be liable to the penalties hereby imposed.”;

“11. a. Any person who violates any provision his bylaw commits an offence.

b. Each separate circumstance where a provision of this Bylaw is violated constitutes a separate offence.

c. Each day’s continuance of an offence constitutes a new and distinct offence.

d. The following persons are hereby designated as authorized to enforce the provisions of this Bylaw:

- i) a Bylaw Enforcement Officer;*
- ii) a Building Official;*
- iii) the Fire Chief;*
- iv) the Deputy Fire Chief.*

e. Where a person is in violation of any provision of this Bylaw, those persons authorized under this Section, Subsection d., may issue a violation notice upon the person in violation; and such person shall be liable to pay the Bowen Island Municipality the respective sum or sums, indicated in the violation notice set out as follows:

First Offence:

\$50.00 for each violation of this Bylaw.

*\$25.00 for each violation if paid within fourteen (14) days
of the issuance of the violation notice.*

Second Offence:

\$100.00 for each violation of this Bylaw.

\$75.00 for each violation if paid within fourteen (14) days of the issuance of the violation notice.

Subsequent Offences:

\$150.00 for each violation of this Bylaw

\$125.00 for each violation if paid within fourteen (14) days of the issuance of the violation notice.

If the penalty indicated on the Violation Notice is not paid within thirty (30) days of the issuance, a Summons may be issued in respect to the violation.

f. Any person named in Section (d) may enter upon property at all reasonable times to ascertain whether the provisions of this Bylaw are being observed.”;

“12. Except as otherwise provided in this Bylaw, every person who violates any of the provisions of this Bylaw, or who suffers or permits any act, or thing, to be done in contravention of this Bylaw, or who refuses, omits, or neglects to fulfill, observe, carry out, or perform any duty or obligation imposed by this Bylaw is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or in the alternative to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months.”; and

“13. Where an owner or occupier fails to affix a number as required by this Bylaw Bowen Island Municipality may affix the number at the entrance to the property and recover the cost of so doing from the owner.”.

3. Sections 11 and 12 of the bylaw are renumbered as Sections 14 and 15 respectively.

READ A FIRST TIME this 13th day of February 2006.


READ A SECOND TIME this 13th day of February 2006.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY ADOPTED this 27th day of February, 2006.


