BOWEN ISLAND MUNICIPALITY

Council Remuneration Bylaw No. 4, 1999

A Bylaw to provide for payment of remuneration for Council Members of the Bowen Island Municipality pursuant to Section 215 of the *Municipal Act*

The Council for the Bowen Island Municipality enacts as follows:

1. **TITLE**

This Bylaw may be cited as “Council Remuneration Bylaw No. 4, 1999.”

2. **REMUNERATION OF COUNCILLORS**

There shall be paid out to council members for discharge of the duties of office, from the annual revenue of said Municipality during each calendar year as follows:

- (a) monthly remuneration at the annual rate of \$14,000. to the Mayor in each month in which the Mayor is appointed under Section 215(1-(a)) of the *Municipal Act*;
- (b) monthly remuneration at the annual rate of \$8,000. to each Councillor in each month in which the Councillor is appointed under Section 215(1-(a)) of the *Municipal Act*.
- (c) On January 1st of each year an annual increase based on the Canadian Consumer Price Index (Vancouver) will be applied to the annual rates established in section (a) and (b) of this bylaw.
- (d) That family coverage for extended health and dental benefits will be made available to those Council members who wish to participate and the Municipality will pay the full costs of providing the benefit. The Municipality’s obligation to provide the benefit is limited to eligibility and enrolment assessment and will be subject to the benefit plan provider’s acceptance of the Council member’s enrolment in the plan.”

3. **INCIDENTAL EXPENSES**

One third of the annual remuneration established for each Council member under Section 2 is paid as an allowance for the expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of the Council member.

4. **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This bylaw shall be considered to have come into force and effect on the 4th day of December 1999.

READ A FIRST TIME this 13th day of December 1999.

READ A SECOND TIME this 10th day of January 2000.

READ A THIRD TIME this 10th day of January 2000.
